Good morning Ms. Henderson,

Thank you for your email regarding door knob hanger ads. I completely understand your concerns; however, there is currently no provision in any City bylaw, including Community Standards Bylaw No. B-09/2012 (CSB), prohibiting the placing of flyers or posters/advertising materials at residents' doors.

This issue did come before Council in 2019 and 2020. I can confirm that the City did get a legal opinion that is summarized in the staff report for Item 9.1 on the June 15, 2020 agenda. Although there was much discussion, in the end, Council chose not to amend the CSB to add this provision.
