BYLAW NO. B-19/2022 OF THE CITY OF AIRDRIE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A bylaw to authorize the rates of taxation to be levied against assessable property within the City of Airdrie for the 2020 taxation year.

- Whereas the City of Airdrie has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues and expenditures as required, at the Council meeting held on **December 13, 2021;** and
- Whereas the estimated municipal revenues from all sources other than property taxation total \$105,922,093; and
- Whereas the estimated municipal expenditures (excluding non cash items) set out in the annual budget for the City of Airdrie for 2022 total \$145,919,277 and the balance of \$39,997,184 is to be raised by general municipal property taxation; and
- Whereas the estimated amount required to repay principal debt to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$6,788,020; and
- Whereas the estimated amount required for current year capital expenditures to be raised by general municipal taxation is **\$0**; and
- Whereas the estimated amount required for future financial plans to be raised by municipal taxation is **\$22,125,990**; and
- Therefore the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$68,911,194; and
- Whereas the requisitions including adjustments for over/under levies are:
