Issue:

Council is being asked to give Second and Third Reading to Borrowing Bylaw No. B-05/2024 to fund the South West Recreation Centre – Design project.

Background:

On March 4 2024, Council gave first reading to Bylaw B-05/2024. This borrowing bylaw is associated with the South West Recreation Centre – Design project. The bylaw is being presented to Council for Second and Third Reading.

All required advertising has been completed and no petition has been received. Pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, Council may now give Second and Third Reading to Bylaw No. B-05/2024.

The City of Airdrie is well within required Provincial debt limits as shown in the chart below.

With the addition of the debenture associated with Bylaw No. B-05/2024, outstanding debt will rise to \$79,243,492. The cumulative debt will rise to \$111,269,992 considering all three borrowing bylaws brought forward today.

The South West Recreation Centre project is for a new recreation facility in the southwest of the city. The recreational center will address some of the demands (based on Airdrie's growing population) on the City's existing recreation facilities. Detailed design is planned for Q3 2024 and will run until Q1 2025, with construction proposed to start in 2025.

The portion of the design project identified in the 2024 Budget to be funded by debenture is **\$12,629,800**.

Debentures are a means for a municipality to acquire debt financing. This type of financing is regulated under the *Municipal Government Act* and requires an approved bylaw. Debenture bylaws have an advertising requirement of two consecutive weeks followed by a fifteen-day petition period. Council may proceed with second and third readings of the bylaw if there are no petitions received. Debenture bylaws are valid thirty days after the second and third readings.

Administration Recommendation:

That Council gives Second and Third Reading to Bylaw No. B-05/2024, being a Debenture Bylaw in the amount of \$12,629,800 to fund the South West Recreation Centre – Design project.

Alternatives/Implications:

- Council could choose to defeat Bylaw No. B-05/2024 at second and third reading. Should the debenture not be approved, this project could be delayed until alternate means of financing are arranged.
- 2. Council could choose to table Bylaw No. B-05/2024 for further review. Should the debenture be tabled, this capital project could be delayed.

Communications Plan:

The debenture was publicly advertised according to *Municipal Government Act* requirements for two consecutive weeks on the following dates March 7th, 2024 and March 14th, 2024 and no petition was received.

Recommendation:

That Council gives Second and Third Reading to Bylaw No. B-05/2024, being a Debenture Bylaw in the amount of \$12,629,800 to fund the South West Recreation Centre – Design project.
