





2024 Accomplishments

- ✓ Successfully transitioned a new service provider for Transit Operations and Maintenance Services
- ✓ Ridership increase of 31% (474,988 trips for the first 8 months of the year)
- ✓ Mobile Fare Revenue increased by 55.4%, compared to 2023
- ✓ E-Scooters travelled 29,455 kms in 2024 (as of June 30)
- ✓ On target to provide the City's 1st Active Transportation Plan!
