Being a bylaw to amend the Committees Bylaw to align with the Policing Committee Bylaw.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c M-26, allows Council to amend bylaws; and

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to amend Committees Bylaw B-11/2024;

The Council of the City of Airdrie enacts as follows:

Amendments

- 1 The *Committees Bylaw* No. B-11/2024 is amended by the following sections:
 - (1) Section 2(4) is deleted and the following is substituted:
 - (4) "advisory committee" means a Council committee established by bylaw that provides advice and recommendations as directed to Council or is required by legislation for a sustained period;
 - (2) Section 47 is amended by adding "; and" after "Affairs";
 - (3) by adding the following after clause 47(1):
 - (2) Policing Committee.

Interpretation

- If any provision of this bylaw is declared invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this bylaw remain valid and enforceable.
- Nothing in this bylaw relieves a person from complying with any provision of any federal or provincial law or regulation, other bylaw, or any requirement of any lawful permit, order, or licence.
- Where this bylaw refers to another act, bylaw, regulation, or agency, it includes reference to any act, bylaw, regulation, or agency that may be substituted for it.
